Navigating regional attractions and proposing a new style of travel Investment Contract Signed under Trip Base Michi-no-eki Stations Project for Regional Revitalization with SPC Developing Hotels

Sekisui House, Ltd. and New Tourism Trip Base 1 LCC, a special purpose company (SPC) that develops 15 hotels in six different prefectures under the Trip Base Michi-no-eki Station Project for regional revitalization, announced the signing of an anonymous association contract on June 17, 2019.

- Eleven organizations agree with the aim of the project and invest in the special purpose company (SPC).
- In the first stage, New Tourism Trip Base 1 LLC develops 15 hotels in six prefectures, which are scheduled to open from the fall of 2020.



New Tourism Trip Base 1 LLC is an SPC founded with investments from 11 organizations and the limited liability company which works as a business operator of Trip Base Michi-no-eki Station Project and develops hotels. The operation concludes building lease contracts with hotel operators, land lease contracts with municipal governments that run Michi-no-eki stations, as well as project management, design and construction contracts with Sekisui House.

In the Trip Base Michi-no-eki Station Project, Sekisui House and Marriott International will cooperate with municipal governments in Japan to facilitate regional revitalization by proposing a travel style of navigating regional attractions for which Michi-no-eki stations serve as hubs. In the first stage of the project, 15 roadside hotels with about 1,000 rooms will be opened in six prefectures in the fall of 2020 and later. The brand of hotels will expand around the country.


